A Personal Note



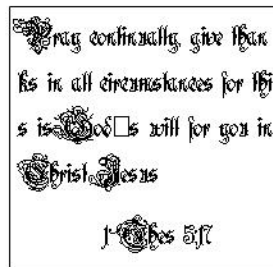
