What exactly is The Roundtable of Faith?

It is a core group consisting of 12 women and a mentoring facilitator. This group represents the 12 disciples and the investment it took to shape their lives to become great leaders for future generations.

There are other membership groups available.

Why should I join The Roundtable of Faith?

We believe no one is meant to walk alone. To do so, stifles growth, learning and reaching maximum potential. The following are just a few reasons why you should consider joining. First, we are first and foremost interested in you and the person you want to become. Second, we offer you several mentoring styles in one roundtable found nowhere else to enhance you personally, spiritually and professionally. Third, we provide teaching, tools and workshops to enhance your leadership development and to discover and/or pursue your passion.

I am extremely busy and pressed for time.

What kind of time commitment am I making?

We meet on a monthly basis for 2 hours. Outside “challenge assignments” will take 2-3 hours per month.

No. Although the focus is Christ-centered, the topics and subjects discussed will teach principles, solutions and practical tips that everyone will benefit from. Are there a minimum number of meetings I can miss?

We want women who are committed. Therefore, members must attend 9 of the 12 annual meetings in order to remain in the Roundtable of Faith. Permission to continue or be dismissed will be granted by the ROF members.

May I invite a guest to attend?

Yes. Once or twice a year, we will open the roundtable to invite guests who wish to learn more about who we are and what we do. Dates to be determined.

When and where will the meeting take place?

We meet on the 2nd Tuesday of each month from 7:00 – 9:00 a.m. at the Georgian Club (includes breakfast). If you evening sessions are desired, please specify in order to make arrangements. If an evening group transpires, it will most likely be from 7:00 – 9:00 p.m. in the Lawrenceville or Suwanee area.

Will there be additional fees?

We do not foresee additional fees, but it is possible. We have made every effort to ensure that the annual and monthly fee provides for any and all services. However, it is possible that materials, tests and/or the service of guest speakers increase. If that happens, the ROF members will be notified in advance in order for the roundtable to make a decision to pay for the additional fee(s) or not.

How will I benefit from my membership?

Your membership provides valued, professional services to help you succeed. First, a professionally trained mentor facilitates and trains the ROF members. In addition, the members benefit from one another through what is called, "co-mentoring." Second, each member receives one-on-one mentoring each month to discuss personal needs, challenges or opportunities. Third, we hire the services of companies or organizations to provide us with quality tests that will best equip each member as a person and a leader. These additional tools help each person learn, grow and excel. Fourth we bring in expert guest speakers who teach from their personal experiences and business ventures.

Do I qualify as a leader to become a ROF member?

We are looking for women who serve in a variety of influential roles. Are presently or potentially in a leadership role? Have you served in a leadership role but you are now serving your family in the home? Are you serving the community in a volunteer capacity? If so, we want you! Fee Structure

Membership fee: \$395 per year

\$95.00 deposit due with application..

\$300.00 is due on or before September 1, 2009.

Monthly dues: \$50.00 p/month.

Monthly fees are due by the 8th of each month.

Members must pay for all 12 monthly dues for the year regardless of attendance.

Fees may be paid monthly, semi-annually or in full.
